- Total building size, 11,310 SF
- Mainline & ramp W.I.M. systems
- Triple deck static scale






























































Mainline Weigh-In-Motion (WIM) technology allows State Patrol inspectors to weigh commercial vehicles at highway speeds.

Commercial vehicles of legal weight do not have to exit to the SWEF unless called in by the inspectors.

Mainline Weigh-In-Motion (WIM) effectively screens the stream of traffic to find overweight vehicles, and directs those vehicles to the static scale for more accurate weighing.
