Local Program Project Types

- Local Bridge Improvement (bridge replacement or rehab)
- STP Rural
- STP Urban
- Hazard Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)
- Transportation Economic Assistance (TEA)
- Transportation Alternatives Programs (TAP)
 - Safe Routes To School (SRTS)
 - Trails, paths
 - Bike/ped facilities

WisDOT Responsibilities

- WisDOT is responsible for:
 - Ensuring that all parties involved in the design and construction of Local Program projects meet their responsibilities
 - Ensuring compliance with State and Federal Standards and Regulations for design and construction projects with utility involvements
 - Reviewing and Processing PS&Es and Utility Documentation for LET
 - Providing construction oversight
 - Serving as a resource to Municipalities, Utility Companies, Design and Construction Engineers, and Contractors

WisDOT Responsibilities

- WisDOT will review:
 - Submittal materials utility correspondence, emails, letters, phone logs to ensure all steps of the utility coordination process have been completed
 - Municipality approval of WORK PLANS (Roadway Permitting Authority), design plans, plat, UTILITY LOG, and USR

Designer provides copy of above to WisDOT 1 month prior to PS&E Approval

WisDOT Responsibilities

- WisDOT is <u>not</u> responsible for:
 - Ensuring the accuracy of plans or utility involvements in PS&Es
 - Approving Utility Work Plans on behalf of the Municipality
 - Granting permits to Utility Companies on behalf of the Municipality
 - Issuing Notice to Proceed to Utility Companies to begin relocations or adjustments within Local Road R/W on behalf of the Municipality

Ensuring Coordination Between PS&E and LET

THIS IS WHERE SPECIAL PROVISIONS ARE IMPORTANT:

Whether the specials state that a utility will be moving PRIOR/DURING –OR- NOT AT ALL...documentation of utility commitments becomes a major factor for bidding and scheduling of construction activities

Sponsor (or Designer, if an agreement is made) is responsible for monitoring and reporting progress of utility relocations between PS&E and LET.

Utility Coordination During Construction

- Conflicts should be resolved between the Sponsor and the Utility.
- WisDOT may assist in matters if a utility conflict can NOT be resolved.

LOCAL PROGRAM PROJECTS DO NOT FALL UNDER ADMINISTRATIVE RULE TRANS 220

- Use of Trans 220 forms is NOT allowed. WisDOT can furnish similar forms that have been created for the Local Program.
- Despite not falling under Trans 220, utility coordination process for all Local Program Projects remains the same, including timeframes necessary for coordination and approval of Utility Work Plans. Following utility coordination LEAD TIMES during design is KEY (60/90/120 calendar days afforded to Utilities for return of Work Plans)

UTILITY COORDINATION MEETINGS

- Operational Planning Meeting (OPM) is required
- Additional meetings may be included based on complexity of project.

UTILITY WORK PLANS FOR PS&E PURPOSES

- Municipality (and Designer) reviews UTILITY WORK PLANS to Account for:
 - WHAT the work is
 - WHEN the work will be done
 - WHO will be doing the work (utility company forces or contractors)
 - WHERE they will be doing the work needed to clear construction

 Once ALL questions are answered, a clear picture should emerge of time lines and activities.

NOTE: When requesting information from a utility, request Station/Outs to describe all relocations of BOTH EXISTING & PROPOSED facilities.

UTILITY STATUS REPORT (USR)

- USR (DT1080) completed by the DESIGNER
- ALL dates and columns are required to be filled in COMPLETELY with appropriate information
- DT 1080 instructions in UC Guide CHAPTER 15

PS&E DOCUMENTS - REVIEW AND TIMING

- ALL UTILITY DOCUMENTS/MATERIALS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO WisDOT FOUR (4) WEEKS PRIOR TO FINAL PS&E DATE (FDM 19-1-1)
- UTILITY SPECIAL PROVISIONS based on Sponsor Approved utility work plans
- USR reflects what is stated in APPROVED UTILITY WORK PLANS and SPECIAL PROVISIONS
- COPIES of correspondence that document commitments stated in PS&E SPECIAL PROVISIONS
- STATUS of any compensable utility interest(s) and copies of those documents

Construction Process Elements

- Preconstruction Meeting utility-related items
 - Address utility concerns
 - Discuss schedules & coordination
- Weekly project meetings
 - Regular attendance by WisDOT and contractor
 - Utilities encouraged to attend, especially when needed for coordination
