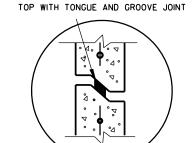

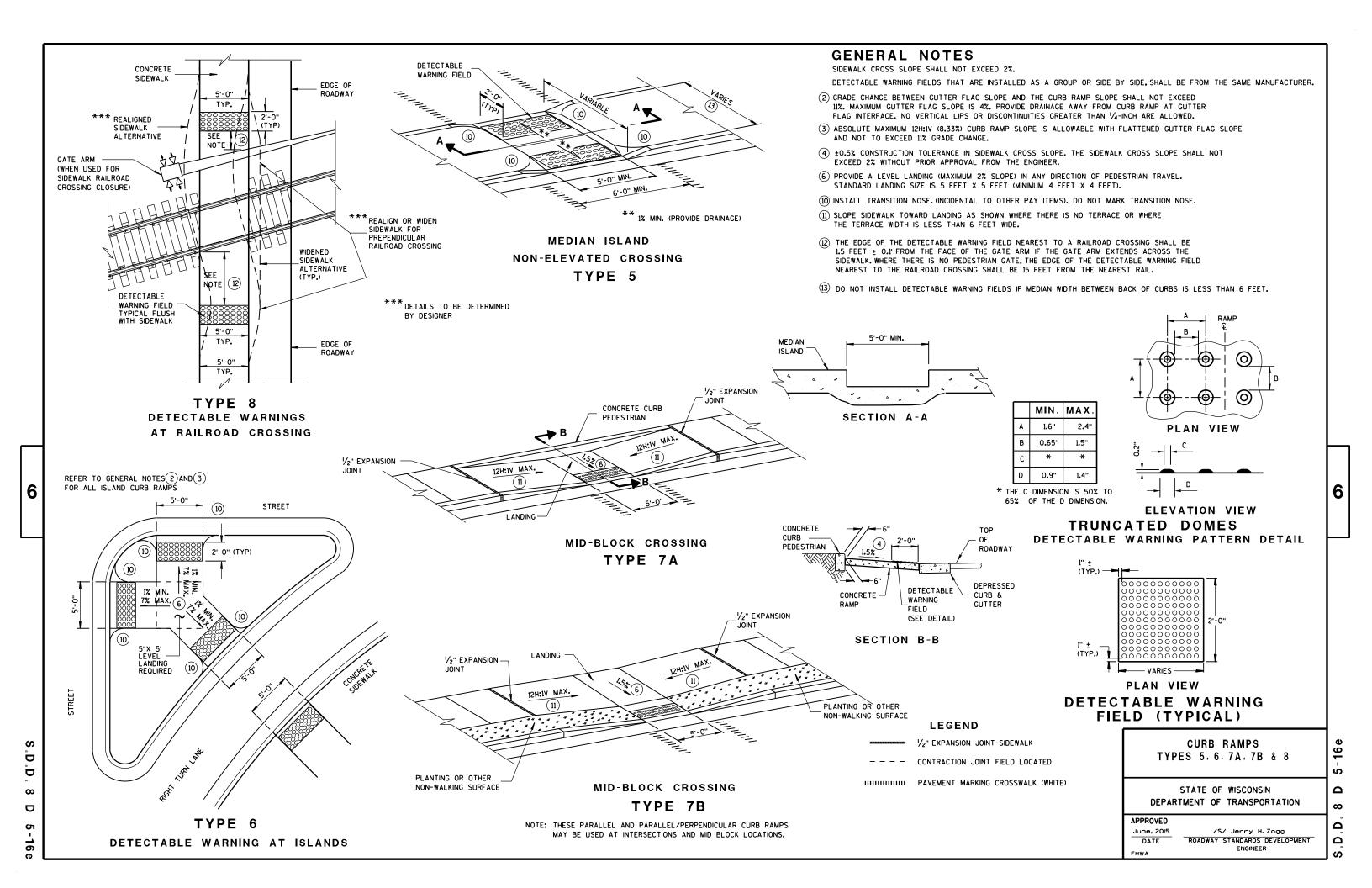
**CURB RAMP TYPE 4B1 PLAN VIEW**

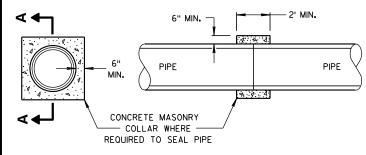


ADJUSTABLE TIE ROD (ALTERNATE NO. 3)

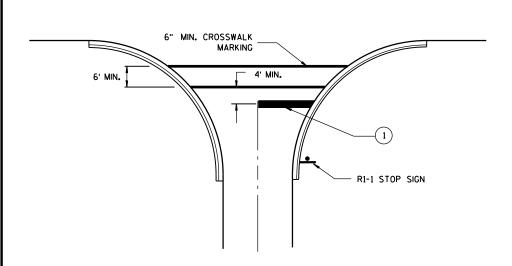


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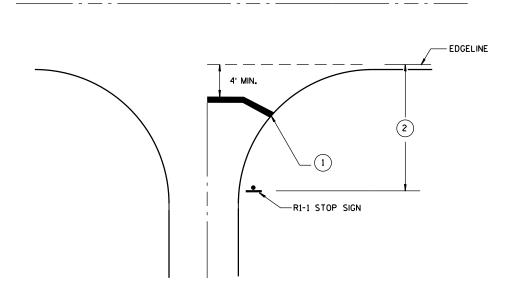
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TYPICAL STOP LINE PAVEMENT MARKING FOR SIDEROADS WITH CROSSWALK MARKING
