Dear Ms. Vicich:

As part of the Department of Transportation improvement projects, the Regional Office routinely manages access (driveways) onto the highway by issuing permits for existing driveways meeting all the statutory requirements.

In reviewing our records, we found that there is no record of a permit for either of your two driveways to USH 63 from your property in the Town of Barronett. Your driveways do not meet our current **DESIRABLE** spacing criteria of **1,000 feet** between driveways on the same side of the road. It has been determined that it is an **acceptable safety risk** to allow the southerly driveway to remain with a waiver of standards for spacing, but the northerly driveway must be removed. We are planning to remove the existing northerly driveway as part of the proposed reconstruction of USH63, currently scheduled for 2015.

The following special provisions apply to the remaining driveway:

- **The existing 18"x26' culvert pipe required for your driveway needs replacing. 6:1 apron endwalls are also required. Replacement of the culvert pipe is the responsibility of the property owner. Cleaning & inspection of the culvert for deterioration should be done periodically.**
- **Any proposed change in land use, traffic volume or type of vehicles utilizing this access, for purposes other than its permitted use, will require the property owner(s) to contact the Department of Transportation for an access determination and permit.**
- **Should reasonable access become available for this property at a non-STH location, WisDOT shall revoke this permit and the connection shall be removed accordingly.**

Your permit should be kept in a safe place that can be accessed readily if an inspector reviews your site during construction and for future reference. If you have any questions, please contact me at 715-635-5059.
