Bridge (S.F.)		Includes all concrete deck area for bridge deck replacement, superstructure replacement, and bridge deck overlays. Does not include box culverts, multiple pipe installations as a bridge, or bridge painting projects.
Milling (S.Y.)		Includes square yards of milling items for: removing pavement (concrete), butt joints; removing asphaltic surface, milling; removing asphaltic surface, butt joints; salvaged asphaltic pavement, milling; mill and overlay asphaltic pavement; and pulverize and relay existing asphaltic pavement.
Diamond Grinding (S.Y.)		Includes square yards of continuous diamond grinding.
Traffic Striping (L.F.)		Includes lineal feet of permanent and temporary pavement marking for lane lines, edge lines, and center lines. Does not include pavement marking for incidental items such as crosswalks, stop lines, curbs, arrows, etc.
Rubblizing (S.Y.)		Includes square yards of rubblizing existing concrete pavement.
