- i. Mr. Sommer has been employed as the Fond du County Highway Engineer since April 29, 2013. During that time, he has served as a Bridge inspection team member for the County under my supervision. He has performed routine, interim, and underwater visual probe inspections for county, city, town and village bridges, including single and multiple-span bridges, steel girders, concrete girders, slab, prestressed, and culverts.
